



Team roster:	Four (4) players 3 + 1 substitute
Referee (s):	One (1) per court
Score keeper:	One (1) per team
Time-outs:	One (1) per team (can't call a timeout in the final three (3) minutes of playing time)
Initial possession:	Paper-scissors-rock (best of one) Note: The team that wins decides whether it takes the ball or leaves it.
Scoring:	One (1) point inside the three-point line and two (2) points scored behind the three-point line (the arc).
Game duration & score limit:	1 x 10 minutes, playing time Score limit: If a team scores 21 points, before regular time expires, the game finishes.
Overtime:	GOLDEN POINT- First team to score wins the game (DO NOT need to win by two (2)).
Free throw(s) following a shooting foul:	One (1) free throw Two (2) free throws, if the foul is committed behind the three-point line (the arc)
Foul limit per team:	Six (6) team fouls
Penalty for team fouls 7,8 and 9:	Two (2) free throws
Penalty for team fouls 10 and more:	Two (2) free throws + ball possession
Penalty for technical foul:	One (1) free throw, no change of possession
Penalty for unsportsmanlike foul:	Two (2) free throws (+ ball possession as of team foul 10 and more)
Penalty for disqualifying foul:	Two (2) free throws + ball possession
Possession following a successful goal:	Defensive possession, Right underneath the hoop, Ball to be dribbled or passed to a player behind the arc. Defensive team not allowed to play for the ball inside the "no charge semi-circle" area underneath the basket.
... following a dead ball:	Check ball exchange behind the arc (at the top)
... following a defensive rebound/steal/ blocked shot:	Ball to be dribbled/passed behind the arc
... following a jump ball situation:	Defensive teams' possession



Substitutions:	In dead ball situations, prior to the check ball, the substitute can enter the game after his teammate steps off the court and establishes a physical contact with him behind the end line opposite the basket. Substitutions require no action from the referees and table officials.
Out of bounds (when you can start defending the opposition):	Edge of semi-circle
Clearing the ball:	Both feet need to be clear of the three point line

Under 10's

The purpose of adding an under 10's grade in our 3v3 competition is so Warwick Senators' next generation can learn and grow the 3v3 side of basketball starting at a young age.

Will there be finals?	No, there won't be any finals as the under 10's program is all about finding the enjoyment for the game of basketball.
What sized rings?	The ring will be at 8 foot sized for the division 2 competition. For the division 1 competition, the ring will be at 10 foot.
Expectation of coaches	1 coach from either team will be expected to be on the court to help assist the players with their understanding of the rules when the game is going.
Scoring	There will be scoring but the scores won't go towards any final's opportunities
Overtime?	There will be no overtime in any game of under 10's 3v3.
